

## May 2, 2022

The Municipal Utility Board met in a Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 2, 2022, with Chairman Harris presiding. The agenda was posted in the outside Pryor City Hall Bulletin Case at 12 North Rowe Street. Members present were: Mr. Garry Harris, Ms. Lorri Mitchell, Dr. Art Sixkiller, Mr. Mark Roberts, and Dr. Ken Rains.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who reported a date correction from March 21, 2022 to April 4, 2022 in the Heading for the April 4, 2022 Minutes approved during the last meeting.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Mr. Roberts to correct the Heading of the Minutes for April 4, 2022 and approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held April 18, 2022. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Rains, Roberts, Sixkiller, Mitchell, and Harris Nay – none

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve Claims #1190 - #1240 totaling \$423,111.24 for payment. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Mitchell, Rains, Roberts, and Harris Nay – none

The Board recognized the Honorable Mayor Lees who reported on his excitement of the continued development interest in and around the City of Pryor Creek. Mayor Lee's stated the target date for occupancy in the new Police and Fire Facility was set for September 2022.

Mr. Crisp added to the Mayor's report, the Bank of Commerce purchased and demolished the old carwash south of their new building on South Adair Street and a Demolition Permit was issued to the Tulsa Teachers Credit Union in preparation of their new construction on the corner of South Mill and SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.

The Board recognized Mr. Dale Burke, P.E. and President of Infrastructure Solutions Group, LLC who discussed a visual presentation of the Pryor Municipal Utility Board Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility Study and Analysis. Mr. Burke's recommendations included \$2,287,500 for Headworks Improvements, \$3,600,000 for SBR/Digester Improvements, \$1,127,500 for Sludge Handling Improvements, and \$2,055,000 for Plant Controls Electrical Improvements. The estimated total project cost to upgrade the ±33 year old wastewater treatment plant facility as recommended in the presentation was \$11,667,900. Mr. Crisp concluded the Analysis could be modified and the Staff was doing a great job with what they have to work with but the WWTP Facility Study and Analysis was necessary for Budget and Planning or seeking grants and loans for all or part of a necessary upgrade project.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who discussed the SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street Lift Station and reported he completed the documents for the CDBG Grant Application and submitted them to Grand Gateway.

Mr. Crisp shared a thank you letter from Mrs. Hannah Moore in regards to the 2022 Public Power Conference and reported his assigned MUB vehicle, Truck #6, was broke into along with several other vehicles parked at the Embassy Suites Hotel and Convention Center in Norman, Oklahoma during the 2022 Public Power Conference.

The Board recognized Mr. Travis Willis who had no report.

The Board recognized Mrs. Teri Hill who reported on a Delinquent Final Billing ordered by the General Manager at 109 Steve Berry Blvd. who had a past due balance from April 1, 2022 and the property management had posted a "Notice of Lockout for non-payment of rent in the amount of \$14,106.00" per Oklahoma Property Code 93002(F) on April 25, 2022. A Surety Utility Deposit Claim against Alban Vrebellaku, doing business as Fratelli's Italian Grill has been filed by the Municipal Utility Board and should cover the cost of utilities exceeding their cash security deposit.

A written Department Foreman's Report was presented with no additional comments.

Mr. Crisp discussed and recommended the re-classification of Mr. Robert Wilkerson to a Regular Employee with a promotion to B-Mechanic Non-Merit in the Water/Wastewater Department, effective May 12, 2022.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Mr. Roberts to re-classify Mr. Robert Wilkerson to a Regular Employee with a promotion to B-Mechanic Non-Merit (\$21.75 per hour to \$23.34 per hour) in the Water/Wastewater Department, effective May 12, 2022. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Rains, Roberts, Sixkiller, Mitchell, and Harris Nay – none

There were no new business or unfinished business to discuss.

There was no Attorney's Report.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to adjourn at 7:17 p.m. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Roberts, Mitchell, Sixkiller, Rains, and Harris Nay – none
